COURSE DESCRIPTION: Theological reflection on the sacramental life of the Church in the context of worship and education in sacramentality.

CLASS OBJECTIVES: Upon completion of this course, the participants would have achieved the following objectives:

- To have an adequate knowledge and understanding of 3 perspectives which highlight the performative nature of the rites of the seven sacraments.
- To establish the connection between the seven sacraments, on the one hand, and the sacramentality of the Church and of Christ, on the other.
- To further develop sacramental awareness and sensitivity.
- To explore concrete pastoral implication and application of the course.

POSSIBLE ASSIGNMENTS/PRESENTATIONS/TESTS:

- To meet the first objective of the course, the participants will work on specific presentations and demonstrate how the perspectives offered by the course apply to each of the seven sacraments.
- To meet the second and third objectives, the participants will analyze the rites of each of the sacraments according to given criteria and actively contribute to the Threaded Discussions by articulating their insights and questions.
- To meet the fourth objective, the participants will work on different projects that pertain to the sacramental experience of parishes to which they belong and/or of students in the Catholic separate school board.

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
