### **DOMESTIC STUDENTS**

These fee tables summarize the fees for students admitted to the SAS Non-Conjoint Programs.

#### **Different Types of Fees:**

- 1. Academic Fees:
  - a. Program: Fees are assessed as a flat rate amount; there may be a full-time and/or part-time rate.
  - b. Course: Fees are assessed on a course by course basis. When a course is added, the course fee is charged immediately regardless, of when the course begins. When a course is canceled, the course fee is reversed in accordance with the Refund Schedule applicable to the student's program.
- c. **Minimum Charge:** A minimum charge of \$329.00 will be charged to students who cancel their registration in the Fall Winter session on or after the published date for the first day of classes in accordance with the Refund Schedule applicable to the student's program.
- 2. Incidental: Compulsory fees for campus and student services (societies).
- 3. Ancillary: Fees relating to enrolment in a specific course or program or for individual circumstances.
- 4. System Access: \$59.25
- 5. Non-Conjoint Student Library Card Options:
  - a. St. Augustine's Seminary Library Card: Free of charge. You may also obtain library cards from the other TST Colleges at no charge. However, the U of T libraries and electronic resources will not be available to you.
- Both full-time and part-time non-conjoint students are now eligible to self-enroll to opt in to the UTSU Health & Dental Plan:

### For academic purposes, the Toronto School of Theology operates on a trimester system:

- 1. Fall Semester (September to December)
- 2. Winter Semester (January to April)
- 3. Summer Semester (May to August)

All fees and charges will be invoiced. Non-receipt of an invoice does not exempt the student from meeting his/her financial obligations.
